Business 1220E introduces students to business fundamentals in finance, marketing, operations, organizational behavior, and general management. It is taught for three hours each week using the case method developed by the Ivey Business School. Enrolment in each section will not exceed 85, and students will be from a variety of programs including Management and Organizational Studies.

Persons applying to teach these courses should have an advanced degree or professional designation and/or significant experience teaching this or a similar course. While preference will be given to candidates prepared to teach all three sections, applications for one or two sections may also be considered.
