Semester Dates	FALL: September to December WINTER: January to April
How to apply Step 1	Applications are due the first week of April. Your home institution must nominate you to become an exchange student at Huron. Please check your school's website or student services area for information on how to begin the exchange process at Huron.
How to apply Step 2	You must discuss exchange requirements with your home institution and then submit your application to Huron. If you are approved by Huron as an exchange student you will then choose your courses that have been approved by Huron.
Course Information	Exchange students must submit a course request form 6-8 weeks before arrival. Browse the course information and then contact your department chair at your home institution. Be sure to search by campus- Huron: http://studentservices.uwo.ca/secure/timetables/mastertt/ttindex.cfm
Accommodation	Accommodation is not guaranteed for incoming exchange students.
Application Deadline	September intake: April 15 th January intake: September 30 th
Visa needed?	Depending on your citizenship, you may need an eTA or a visitor visa, as well as a study permit: www.cic.gc.ca/english/helpcentre/answer.asp?qnum=523&top=15
Study Permit?	Foreign nationals need a study permit to study in Canada depending on the length of their exchange: https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/corporate/publications-manuals/operational-bulletins-manuals/temporary-residents/study-permits/who-needs-study-permit.html
Health Insurance	All exchange students are required to have valid health insurance to study in Ontario, Canada. This can be purchased through Huron.
Costs	Tuition is paid to your home institution. You are responsible for living and travel expenses. You are responsible for other costs you may incur: student union fees, orientation fees, club fees, etc.
