

In-Course Scholarship Application Form 2019-2020

Eligibility: In-course scholarships are available to students entering 2nd-year or above. In order to be eligible to receive an upper-year scholarship, you must be a full-time Huron student returning to Huron in 2019-2020 and be enrolled in 5.0 courses during the regular academic year (September to April), 3.0 of which must be Huron courses. Students must submit an application to be considered for in-course scholarships. The scholarships are adjudicated on the basis of performance and adherence within specific award criteria. If you receive an in-course scholarship, you will be notified by the Student Awards Committee in the summer.
